Module Manual – i2CanPay 4.6

License Agreement

By downloading i2CanPay 4.6 installation package, you agree to be bound by the terms of following agreement:

1. The i2CanPay 4.6 Module is provided as is
2. You or your organization will be the only owner of the downloaded installation packages. Passing it to any 3rd party without our permission is not allowed and will lead to loss of any upgrade and support entitlements.
3. You are not allowed to reverse engineer, decompile, and disassemble the downloaded packages. Failing to comply with this term will lead to legal action.

We will avoid further business with any individual or organization that breaches this agreement.

Instructions for DotNetNuke Host Users

A. The i2CanPay Module is provided as is and has only been test on DotNetNuke versions 4.6.2 - 4.9.1. Installation on other versions it not recommended.

B. In order for emails to be processed please ensure SMTP Server Settings are properly defined

Setup

1. Place the i2CanPay module on a DNN page
2. Go to module “settings”
3. Enter the email address in which all notification emails will be sent
4. Enter credit card gateway information and corresponding account number(s)
5. Select allowed payment methods

If you wish to create a catalog and shopping cart:

1. Place the “i2CanPay – Shopping Cart” module on a DNN page
2. Go to module “settings” and “i2CanPay – Shopping Cart Settings”
3. Place a link to the page the i2CanPay is located on.

Product Catalog / Shopping Cart

This feature will allow you to create multiple product links.

Step 1: Create a Product Link

1. In the i2CanPay – Shopping Cart Module, select “Shopping Cart Link” in the module edit tool
2. Enter an Item Name, Item Cost (no \$ symbol needed), and Item Notes (optional)
3. Click “generate link”
4. Copy the provided link

Step 2: Place link into previously created product page

1. In any previously created DNN page, use the Text/HTML editor to insert your link. This can be either text or an image

Direct Buy

This will allow you to purchase a single item only (no shopping cart)

Step 1: Create a direct buy Link

1. In the i2CanPay module, select “Direct Buy Link” in the module edit tool
2. Enter an Order Amount (no \$ symbol needed), Invoice Number (optional) and Product
3. Click “generate link”
4. Copy the provided link

Step 2: Place link into previously created product page

1. In any previously created DNN page, use the Text/HTML editor to insert your link. This can be either text or an image

Bill Pay / Donations / Dues Payments

This will allow users to submit a payment amount of their choosing

Step 1: Place the i2CanPay module on a DNN page and configure settings (as per “Setup” instructions)

The i2CanPay – Shopping Cart module need not be placed on a page.

Once the i2CanPay module is placed on a page, purchasers may enter a bill payment, donation or dues payment – entering a free-form dollar amount.

View Orders

1. In the i2CanPay module, select “View Orders” from the module edit tool
2. Order data can be filtered by Inactive (deleted), Incomplete, At Gateway, Complete, or All
3. Click the magnifying glass to view details of a specific order
4. To export to CSV, select “payments” from the pull-down and click “Run”

Manage Messages

1. In the i2CanPay module, select “Messages” from the module edit tool
2. From the Message Name pull-down, select the message you wish to edit
3. Content for the selected message can be altered in the “Message Value” area
4. To insert Message Fields, copy from the provided tags in the Message Field area and paste into the Message Value
